Count I. Assault 1st Degree - Serious Physical Injury (565.050-001Y19841304.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.050, RSMo, committed the class A felony of assault in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about August 28, 2016, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly caused serious physical injury to [REDACTED] by shooting him.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y19755213.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the felony of armed criminal action, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015., RSMo, in that on or about August 28, 2016, in the county of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Assault in the 1st Degree charged in Count 1, all allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Assault in the First Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 08-28-2016 officers of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department were dispatched to 6620 E 67 street on a shooting. The dispatcher updated the address to 6633 Broadmoor Rd, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. The location of the shooting was found to be **6630 Broadmoor Rd, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri.**

Officers contacted a witness () in the area of E 66 Ter. who said she knows the suspect by the name of Black and she recorded the incident on her cell phone video.

Detectives responded to an area hospital where the victim was listed in critical condition with life threatening injuries. Detectives interviewed witnesses who transported the victim by private vehicle to the hospital, these witnesses said they were at Naaman Williams' residence when an argument became physical and Williams produced a revolver and shot the victim.


Another witness contacted detectives at Police Headquarters and said she was with Williams inside his residence and observed him with a revolver and with a shirt or cloth covering a bleeding wound on his hand. The witness said Williams told her he shot the gun, but not that he shot someone.

When detectives attempted to interview the witness she became uncooperative. A search warrant was obtained through Jackson County Circuit Court for her cellular telephone. The video of the incident was downloaded and showed Williams holding a two tone revolver and arguing with the victim and others while chasing the victim around a vehicle.

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT FORM

Officers located and apprehended Williams at his residence. The revolver was subsequently located and recovered. Williams waived his rights and provided a statement to detectives. Williams initially claimed the victim produced a gun, and then changed his story when confronted by the video evidence, but still claimed he shot in self-defense.
