COMPLAINT WARRANT REQUESTED

Count I. Robbery - 1st Degree (570.023-001Y20171209.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 570.023, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of robbery in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 5, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant forcibly stole a 2004 Nissan Maxima, VIN 1N4BA41E44C924782 in the possession of Confidential Victim _______, and in the course thereof defendant threatened the immediate use of a deadly weapon against Confidential Victim ______.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

Count II. Kidnapping - Facilitating A Felony - Inflicting Injury - Terrorizing - 1st Degree (565.110-002Y19501007.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.110, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of kidnapping in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 5, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, defendant unlawfully confined Confidential Victim for a substantial period, without Confidential Victim's consent because defendant bound, gagged, and blindfolded Confidential Victim. for the purpose of terrorizing Confidential Victim.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count III. Assault 1st Degree Or Attempt (565.050-002Y19791305.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.050, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of assault in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 5, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant repeatedly shot at Confidential Victim with a pellet gun in the face, and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the offense of assault in the first degree of Confidential Victim, and was done for the purpose of committing such assault.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count IV. Assault 1st Degree Or Attempt (565.050-002Y19791306.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.050, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of assault in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 5, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant strangled Confidential Victim, and such conduct was a substantial step toward the commission of the offense of assault in the first degree of Confidential Victim, and was done for the purpose of committing such assault.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count V. Sodomy Or Attempted Sodomy - 1st Degree (566.060-001Y20131115.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.060, RSMo, committed the felony of sodomy in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.060, RSMo, and subject to lifetime supervision under Section 217.735, RSMo, in that on or about January 26, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant for the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual desire of defendant knowingly had deviate sexual intercourse with Confidential Victim ______. by the use of forcible compulsion

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The offense of Sodomy in the First Degree is a felony for which the authorized term of imprisonment is life imprisonment or a term of years not less than five.

Count VI. Rape Or Attempted Rape - 1st Degree (566.030-001Y20131103.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.030, RSMo, committed the offense of rape in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.030, RSMo, and subject to lifetime supervision under Section 217.735, RSMo, in that on or about January 26, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly had sexual intercourse with Confidential Victim ______. by the use of forcible compulsion.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The offense of Rape in the First Degree is a felony for which the authorized term of imprisonment is life imprisonment or a term of years not less than five years.

Count VII. Kidnapping - Facilitating A Felony - Inflicting Injury - Terrorizing - 1st Degree (565.110-002Y19501004.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.110, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of kidnapping in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 26, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, defendant unlawfully confined Confidential Victim ______. for a substantial period, without Confidential Victim ______. 's consent because defendant bound and gagged Confidential Victim ______. with duct tape for the purpose of facilitating the commission of the felony of Rape.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count VIII. Assault - 3rd Degree (565.054-002Y20171306.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.054, RSMo, committed the **class E felony of assault in the third degree**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about January 26, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly caused physical injury to Confidential Victim . by striking Confidential Victim ...

The range of punishment for a class E felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed four (4) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count IX. Sodomy Or Attempted Sodomy - 1st Degree - Aggravated Sexual Offense (566.060-002Y20171115.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.060, RSMo, committed the felony of sodomy in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.060, RSMo, and subject to lifetime supervision under Section 217.735, RSMo, in that on or about January 26, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant for the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual desire of the defendant knowingly had deviate sexual intercourse with Confidential Victim ______. and subjected Confidential Victim ______. to deviate sexual intercourse with more than one person by the use of forcible compulsion

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The offense of Sodomy in the First Degree is a felony for which the authorized term of imprisonment is life imprisonment or a term of years not less than five years, unless the offense is an aggravated sexual offense, in which case the authorized term of imprisonment is life imprisonment or a term of years not less than ten years.

Count X. Sodomy Or Attempted Sodomy - 1st Degree (566.060-001Y20131115.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.060, RSMo, committed the felony of sodomy in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.060, RSMo, and subject to lifetime supervision under Section 217.735, RSMo, in that on or about May 31, 2019, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant for the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual desire of the defendant knowingly had deviate sexual intercourse with Confidential Victim ______. by the use of forcible compulsion

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The offense of Sodomy in the First Degree is a felony for which the authorized term of imprisonment is life imprisonment or a term of years not less than five years.

Count XI. Kidnapping - Facilitating A Felony - Inflicting Injury - Terrorizing - 1st Degree (565.110-002Y19501007.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.110, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of kidnapping in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about May 31, 2019, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, defendant unlawfully confined Confidential Victim ______. for a substantial period, without Confidential Victim's consent because defendant tied up Confidential Victim and placed her in the trunk of a car for the purpose of terrorizing Confidential Victim

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count XII. Kidnapping - Facilitating A Felony - Inflicting Injury - Terrorizing - 1st Degree (565.110-002Y19501007.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.110, RSMo, committed the **class B felony of kidnapping in the first degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about May 31, 2019, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, defendant unlawfully confined Confidential Victim ______. for a substantial period, without Confidential Victim ______. 's consent because defendant handcuffed Confidential Victim ______. to a tree for the purpose of facilitating the flight after the commission of the felony of Sodomy.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served. The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the statement(s) of facts filed contemporaneously herewith, made a part hereof, and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

In regard to CRN 19-40737

On 06/02/2019 at 10:46 a.m., Officers with the Kansas City Missouri Police Department were dispatched to 8925 E. Longview Rd., Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri in regard to a disturbance. The reporting party stated he heard a female yelling for help so he called the police. Officers located the victim who was handcuffed to a tree.

The victim stated she met the suspect, later identified as Kevin W. March (B/M, 03/31/80) on Craigslist. The victim came to Kansas City, Missouri with and met up with March. The victim and March drove back to Sweet Springs, Mo then just March and the victim returned. Enroute to Kansas City the victim said she was forced by March's "body language" to orally ingest a substance she believed was Meth. Once back in Kansas City in the area of 85th and State Line Rd., Jackson County, Missouri the victim said March forced her to smoke marijuana. March drove the victim (in the victim's vehicle) to a wooded area where they had consensual vaginal intercourse. March and the victim then went to an unknown location where they committed a Burglary. They left that area and went to another location where March produced a handgun and forced the victim to accompany him while he committed another Burglary. Afterwards March ordered the victim to disrobe, duct taped her hands and feet then forced her into the trunk of her own vehicle. March drove around all day on 06/01/19 with the victim in the trunk of the vehicle. March and the victim eventually ended up at Long View Lake, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri at or near shelter 18 or 19. March took the victim out of the trunk

and forced her to perform oral sex on him. Afterwards March drove the victim (in her vehicle) to the area of 8925 Longview Road where he handcuffed her to a tree. In addition March configured a ball gag out of the victim's shirt, and tied the gag around her head, covered her head, as if a hood, with her shirt, and duct taped her hands and feet. March told the victim he "had to do something, and she couldn't be involved", and that he would return in a couple hours. March left in the victim's vehicle and never returned. The victim was admitted to a local hospital for her injuries.

Officers observed the suspect vehicle (victim's vehicle) and a vehicle pursuit was initiated utilizing police lights and audible sirens. The suspect vehicle was traveling southbound on Paseo/Dr. Martin Luther King Blvd, Next, the vehicle ran a stoplight at Paseo/Dr. Martin Luther King Blvd and Clever II heading eastbound. Next, the vehicle moved into oncoming traffic while traveling, eastbound on Clever II. Vehicle failed to yield at a stoplight at Prospect Ave and Swope Pkwy traveling eastbound. Vehicle continued on Swope Pkwy and failed to yield at a stoplight at Swope Pkwy and Swope Pkwy traveling eastbound. Next, the suspect vehicle traveled eastbound on Blue Parkway traveling at speeds of approximately 70 mph. Next, we entered I-435 Hwy southbound traveling at speeds of approximately 90-105 mph. The suspect vehicle exited I-435 Hwy onto I 470 eastbound traveling at speeds of approximately 120 mph. The suspect vehicle exited I-470 Hwy onto Raytown road northbound traveling at speeds of approximately 100 mph. The suspect turned westbound on 87th Street traveling at speeds of approximately 80 mph. The suspect vehicle struck stop sticks on 87th Street and I-435 northbound. The suspect vehicle entered I-435 Hwy northbound traveling at speeds of approximately 80 mph when the suspect vehicle came to a rolling stop on I-435 Hwy northbound just south of Gregory Blvd. The suspect was arrested and identified as being March. It was discovered that March had seven priors for driving a motor vehicle with a revoked driver's license.

During an inventory of the suspect vehicle prior to towing it a BB gun was recovered. Detective's observed the victim's hands, wrists and arms were swollen and she had abrasions on her back.

March was transported to a Police Holding Facility then eventually questioned by detectives. After waiving his Miranda Warning March made a statement. March admitted to committing a Burglary in Independence, Mo. March said he knew he was not supposed to be operating a motor vehicle and admitted to leading the police on a lengthy car chase. March said the handcuffs the victim was restrained with were his and said she must have taken them out of his bag. March said all sexual contact with the victim was consensual and denied binding or restraining her in any way.

In regard to CRN 20-1101

On 01/05/2020 at approximately 1233 hours, Officers of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department responded to 8609 Newton Ave Apt. #2308, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri in regard to a Kidnapping. Upon arrival officers made contact with B who stated "Wesley March" later identified as Kevin Wesley March B/M 03/31/1980 stole her car, assaulted her and held her against her will.

stated the following: A few years ago she met March on the Craigslist dating site. For a year, they met on several different occasions and had consensual sex. and March stopped communicating with each other for over a year. On 01/04/2020, March contacted Busing Facebook messenger asking to have sex.

to meet and March came over to TLB's residence (8609 Newton Ave Apt. #2308). After the two had sexual
intercourse. By wanted March to leave and he left shortly after. was getting ready for bed when she
noticed her set of keys that contained her house and car keys were missing. She went outside and noticed that
her vehicle was missing from the parking lot. L messaged March about her vehicle (Gray, 2004 Nissan
Maxima, MS1A2V/MO, 1N4BA41E44C924782) and she asked that he return it or she will file a stolen auto
report. On 01/05/2020 around 0530 hours TBL reported her vehicle stolen. When March returned that morning
at 0915 hours. bathroom and place her in the shower. An unknown amount of time passed when heard another unfamiliar
voice inside the apartment. was able to free herself and when she looked out the bathroom door she
observed March having sex with an unknown W/F in her bed. March caught and he tied her up again and
placed her in the bedroom closet and shut the door. was able to untie herself again, she exited from the
closet, ran towards the front of the apartment and grabbed a steak knife out of the kitchen before running
outside searching for help.

Officers observed a large amount of dried blood, swelling, lumps and redness all over ""'s face. There was

Officers observed a large amount of dried blood, swelling, lumps and redness all over 's face. There was fresh blood on the wall in the bedroom, the closet and rope twine in multiple places throughout the apartment. was transported to an area Hospital for treatment.

On 2/13/20 at 1815 hours March was arrested on a stop order for the Sex Crimes Section, and transported to a Police Facility for processing. On 2/13 at 2025 hours Detectives from the Sex Crimes Section and the Domestic Violence Unit responded to East Patrol and conducted a suspect interview with March. At 2027 hours March was escorted to an interview room where he was read his Miranda Warning and Waiver, stated he understood his rights and agreed to speak to the reporting Detectives. During March's interview he requested his attorney before the specific facts pertaining to this case could be discussed.

In regard to CRN 20-6617

On 01/27/2020 at approximately 1522 hours, officers of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department were dispatched to Cass Regional Medical Center, 2800 E. Rockhaven Rd, Harrisonville, Missouri in regards to a reported rape. Upon arrival officers contacted the victim (who stated she was raped in multiple locations within Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri by an unknown black male, later identified as the suspect, Kevin W. March B/M 03/31/1980.

Officers observed a small laceration on DM's chin and small scrapes on her hands. DM told officers her neck, chest and shoulders were painful to the touch, and her right eye felt swollen. A sexual assault examination was completed.

DM stated the following: On 01/26/2020 she checked into the Extended Stay Hotel at 550 E. 105th Street, Kansas City, MO. DM left the hotel and was walking through the hotel parking lot to go to a BP Gas Station nearby when March drove up next to an unknown make/model, light blue, 4 door sedan and asked if

she needed a ride. said yes to the ride and got into the vehicle. While driving down the road, March punched in the head for tossing a small pizza box out the window while he was driving. March drove to an apartment complex parking lot in the area of 96th Pl and Drury Ave, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri where March assaulted and raped and forced to give him oral sex. March then tied hands together with black duct tape and wrapped the black duct tape around DM's mouth and face. March then briefly removed the duct tape covering for smouth and forced to swallow an unknown amount of "meth". Using one hand March forced an unknown amount of "meth" inside for svagina and anus causing a burning sensation in both. screamed and attempted to get out of the vehicle, but was unable to do so. March made take off all her clothes so she was naked and wouldn't try to get out of the vehicle again. March drove back to the Extended Stay Hotel where she was staying and raped her again inside the vehicle.
March then drove to the Walmart at 10300 E. State Rte 350, Raytown, Jackson County, Missouri where he raped again in the vehicle while in the parking lot. March took scell phone away from her and tried to trade it in at a kiosk inside the Walmart. After leaving Walmart, March drove to an unknown parking lot where he raped yet again.
March then drove to an unknown residence in Kansas City, MO where he met up with a friend he referred to as "Tony" and forced to give "Tony" oral sex. After leaving "Tony's", March drove to Raytown, MO and went to a vacant, newly built home where March forced entry. March brought inside the home and had her take off all her clothes, raped and forced her to give him oral sex. March realized he lost his cell phone and threatened to burn the house down with inside if she didn't tell him what happened to his cell phone. March made DM take a bath and get dressed, then taped has hands together and forced her back into the vehicle. March drove to the area of 87th Street and Longview or Applewood Dr where he found his cell phone laying on the road. After getting his cell phone March drove to Harrisonville, MO to a home where he contacted a female friend he called "Ashley." March made take a shower at "Ashley's" and watched March, "Ashley", and an unknown black male all smoke meth. March then left "Ashley's" residence leaving behind, but called a short time later and told "Ashley" to have meet him at the Casey's General Store near "Ashley's apartment. Fearing what might happen to her walked to Casey's, but before leaving "Ashley" gave a piece of paper with "Ashley's" phone number and told walked to Casey's until an employee called the Harrisonville Police Department. Once the police arrived at Casey's and contacted was until an employee called the March did to her.

On 02/03/2020, an investigative want was issued for March. During the course of the investigation an address was developed and surveillance was conducted regarding March's whereabouts. On 02/13/2020 March was seen exiting the address and was taken into custody on the investigative want. March was transported to the Detention Unit at East Patrol Division Station.

March was checked out of detention at 2027 hours and escorted to an interview room. March was read his Miranda Warning and Waiver and after stating he understood his rights, he agreed to speak with detectives. March stated he could not recall any details from 1/26/2020, but did stay at the Extended Stay Motel located at 550 E. 105th Street for a night or two that weekend. March said he's pretty sure he stayed at the hotel all weekend and didn't go anywhere other than outside to smoke a cigarette. March was asked if anyone

approached him asking for a ride, which he responded no. March then stated he met "Mesha" at the hotel and they drove around south KC in his blue Ford Taurus. March stated they drove around, smoked and they had consensual sex in his car. March stated he did not rape anyone and he did not rape that girl, referring to "Mesha". March denied physically restraining saying he only held her hands from behind. March stated he took "Mesha's" phone to Walmart on State Line and put it in the eco machine and received \$10.00 for it. The interview concluded at 2135 hours and March was escorted back to the detention.

I am requesting an arrest warrant be issued for March, and a bond be associated to that warrant based on March's criminal history; his prior charges for assault and domestic assault, the threat of physical harm that March presents to the victims, and the fact that March is a flight risk. He is currently out on bond in regard to resisting arrest from a car chase. There have been three reported incidents since June of 2019 involving March and similar accusations of drug use by force and the use of restraints on victims while physically or sexually assaulting them.
