## <u>INFORMATION IN LIEU OF INDICTMENT</u>

In the Circuit Court of Jackson County, Missouri, at Kansas City, Term, 2021. In Division Number 14 thereof, designated by the rules of said Court as Criminal Division 14.

## Count I. Murder 2nd Degree (565.021-001Y198409990)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.021, RSMo, committed the **class A felony of murder in the second degree**, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about April 1, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant with the purpose of causing serious physical injury to Damen Taylor caused the death of Damen Taylor by shooting him, and defendant is further given notice that should the state submit murder in the second degree - felony under Section 565.021.1(2), RSMo, it will be based on the death of Damen Taylor as a result of the perpetration of the class B felony of Unlawful Use of a Weapon under Section 571.030.1(9), RSMo, committed by defendant.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class A felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years and not to exceed thirty (30) years, or life imprisonment.

## **Count II. Armed Criminal Action (571.015-001Y197552990)**

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 571.015, RSMo, committed the **felony of armed criminal action**, punishable upon conviction under Section 571.015.1, RSMo, in that on or about April 1, 2020, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant committed the felony of Murder in the Second Degree as charged in Count I, all allegations of which are incorporated here by reference, and the defendant committed the foregoing felony of Murder in the Second Degree by, with and through, the knowing use, assistance and aid of a deadly weapon.

The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of three (3) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a second offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of five (5) calendar years. The range of punishment for the offense of Armed Criminal Action in violation of section 571.015 RSMo. as a third offense is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than ten (10) years without eligibility for parole, probation, conditional release or suspended imposition or execution of sentence for a period of ten (10) calendar years. Any punishment imposed pursuant to section 571.015 RSMo. shall be in addition to any punishment provided by law for the crime committed by, with, or through the use, assistance, or aid of a dangerous instrument or deadly weapon.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Murder and Armed Criminal Action

Data: 4/3/2020

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 4/1/2020, at approximately 1710 hours, officers of the Kansas City, Missouri Police were dispatched to 9415 E. 39<sup>th</sup> Street on a reported shooting. Upon arrival, officers were told by witnesses a male had been shot and transported by private vehicle to a local hospital. Officers located a small amount of blood in the street in front of 9412 E. 39<sup>th</sup> Street. Multiple witnesses were located. The victim, Damen Taylor (B/M 8/6/2001) was transported to TMC where he subsequently died. The Jackson County Medical Examiner ruled the death a homicide.

A search of the crime scene resulted in locating two 9mm shell casings.


Witness #1, , stated she was in her house when she heard a loud commotion outside. She looked out of her window and saw a crowd in the middle of E. 39<sup>th</sup> Street, west of her house. The people appeared to be fighting. doserved a black male with a stocky build, fighting another skinny black male in the street. The stocky black male pushed the skinny black male to the ground and pulled out a gun. He shot the skinny black male three times and walked east towards the intersection of E 39th Street and Crescent Avenue where a white four door vehicle was parked. The male got in the vehicle and it sped away northbound on Crescent Avenue. did not get a good look at the stocky black male but he did have a short afro hairstyle.

Witness #2, stated he was on his way home and was pulling up to the intersection at 39<sup>th</sup> and Crescent. He saw a white car parked on Crescent on the south side of 39<sup>th</sup> and a light blue or silver Mercedes parked on Crescent on the north side of 39<sup>th</sup>. As he was southbound on Crescent, he looked to the east and saw multiple people fighting in the ditch in front of 9412 E. 39<sup>th</sup>. A black male in a tan or beige shirt and blue pants pulled out a gun and shot another male 2-3 times at close range. He put his car in reverse and accelerated back down the street until he got to 3720 Crescent. He saw 2 males outside the house and told them to call 911. He then saw the Mercedes and the white car drive past him at a high rate of speed.

The male at 3720 Crescent was contacted. He had video on his house. He consented to a search for his video system. He stated he got a look at the driver of the Mercedes. He viewed a lineup and identified the photo of Crae Dudley as the driver of the Mercedes.

Witness #3, was at the scene and witnessed the incident. She stated on 4/1/2020 a short "chubby" black male wearing black clothing and jeans knocked on her door at 9415 E 39 Street. She answered the door and did not recognize

about 5'08" wearing a gray Kangol style hat. The other suspect was described as a black male in his late 20s with long

dreads, pulled into a pony tail. The gun was a black and silver semi-auto pistol approached the suspect who had the gun earlier, who was wearing the Kangol hat. He handed the hat and jacket to the suspect with dreads. The suspect who had previously had the jacket and Kangol hat started throwing punches with the fight continued across the street into the drainage ditch. The suspect with the dreads pulled out a gun and fired two rounds at the victim, which struck him. was unable to identify the suspects in a photo lineup.
Witness #7, , stated she was at her aunt's house at 9418 E. 39 <sup>th</sup> Street on 4/1/2020. She did not see how the fight started, but when she got outside, she saw boxing with a black male. slipped and , the victim went to help him. That is when the suspect with dreads shot the victim.
Witness #8 provided a formal interview. He stated on 4/1/2020, Crae Dudley came to his house. He came and asked for a jack back. The first time he came to the door said he looked normal, but after that, he appeared high. left the house and when he came back Crae was yelling "Bitch ass nigger, I need my jack!" He was waiving a gun around as he was yelling told Crae to get off of the porch, which he did. As he left the porch Crae pushed crae and began fighting and the fight moved to the street. During the fight, Crae fell and it is then that believed Crae dropped his gun and the other male with Crae picked it up. The fight continued into a ditch and multiple people were trying to break up the fight. said he believed the fight went too far and Crae was being beat up. heard two gunshots. The victim stood up and stated "Damn I got shot!" Crae, the other male and female who was with Crae got in their cars and drove off. MH positively identified Crae Dudley in a photo lineup. He knew his name because his baby's mother kept yelling it during the fight.
On 4/3/2020 at about 1358 hours, Caylon Dudley was picked up. He was transported to Headquarters and was escorted to one of the interview rooms. Caylon Dudley was read his Miranda rights and he stated he understood his rights. He stated he received a call from his brother, Crae Dudley, to come to the area of 9418 E. 39th Street to assist him while he got his jack back. He went over to the house and he and his brother had a verbal argument with the occupants of the house. One of the males in the house came out to fight. Crae and the male agreed to have a one-on-one fight. Crae handed his jacket and his gun, a Taurus G2 9mm, to Caylon and they started fighting in the street. The fight moved to the ditch and a female came out of the house and started hitting Crae. Caylon was holding the gun in his right hand and was holding the female back with his left hand. The victim then came out of the house and started hitting Crae. He hit Crae several times and then stepped back to pull up his pants. When he went back up to Crae to hit him again, Caylon pointed the gun in his direction and fired two times. He realized the victim was hit and he ran to his car and drove off. He stated he shot because he was in fear for his safety.
Caylon stated he and his brother met up at his house after the shooting. He gave the gun back to his brother. When Crae Dudley was picked up on 4/3/2020, he had a Taurus G2 9mm on him. It was sent to the Police Crime Lab and test fired. Examination of the test fired casing and the 9mm casings from the scene showed they were fired from the same weapon.
Caylon Dudley signed a consent to search for his phone. His phone was searched and there were numerous text messages between Caylon and Crae. There is one from Caylon to Crae stating "Whatever you do Not repeat Do not get rid of yo shytIt will ruin my self-defense caseits legalno need to discard of itthere is no need to discard of it if there was no crime & you need if for protection!!" His phone also had an internet search for Stand Your Ground laws.
Due to the violent nature of the act and it involving a firearm, and for the safety of the community, the case detective is requesting a warrant in lieu of a summons for the offender, Caylon Dudley.
