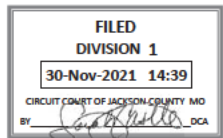


PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT FORM

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 11/28/2021 at approximately 1531 hours, officers were dispatched to 1301 Jackson, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri in regard to a reported armed disturbance.

The victim [REDACTED] stated that he was dispatched by his company (North Kansas City Bureau of Investigation) to the Nova Green Recycling Center, located at 1301 Jackson Ave. His dispatcher informed him that an unknown male was on live feed camera and was stealing items from the companies fenced in property. He was familiar with the property and that thefts were common. Upon arrival, he observed an older white hatchback with dark tinted windows parked at an angle along the fence. He was unable to locate a front license plate and the vehicle appeared to be unoccupied. A little further down the fence he observed the suspect loading scrap metal into a cooler. [REDACTED] parked and approached the suspect on foot. The suspect began to approach [REDACTED] and wanted to know what was going on. He told the suspect that he was going to be detained until police officers arrived because he was stealing. He then told the suspect to place his hands behind his back, so he could place him in handcuffs. The suspect told him no and [REDACTED] produced his Taser and again told the suspect to put his hands behind his back. At that time the suspect pulled a small black pistol from his pants and pointed it at him while saying "This ain't happening." The suspect then ran back to the white hatchback without the cooler and got into the driver's seat and left the area.

[REDACTED] described the suspect as: white male with unknown color of hair, who was wearing a black hoodie, blue covid mask, black sweatpants, blue plastic gloves, and white Nike shoes with a red swish. He had a tattoo over his right eyebrow that was cursive writing. He was unable to read the tattoo. [REDACTED] described the weapon as a small black semi-automatic pistol, possibly a Kel-Tec .380. The victim initially described the suspect vehicle as a 1990's white Volkswagen hatchback with tinted windows and no front license plate.

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Responding officers checked LPR cameras at 13th & Jackson and located a 1997 white Honda Accord at 1527 hours. They observed a license plate of **TH6U8C** and ran it through DOR and it came back to **Bryan Medlin**. The DOR photo showed a white male with a cursive tattoo above his left eye.

On 11/29/2021 at 1548 hours, officers were in the area of 14th & Spruce Ave when they observed a white 1997 Honda Accord station wagon with a broken back window that was covered in tape. The vehicle was bearing Missouri plate "**TH6U8C**." They followed the vehicle and conducted a car check at 9th & Kensington Ave. The occupant who was later identified as **Medlin, Bryan M, w/m, 12/30/1986** was observed to have a cursive tattoo above his left eye consistent with the suspect from the robbery.

Search incident to arrest a **black Ruger LCP .380 Serial# 372466930** handgun was located in Medlin's front right pocket. The firearm was in a black holster and loaded with six .380 rounds in the magazine. A check of the weapon was conducted and did not respond as stolen. He was transported to EPD for booking.

The vehicle, **white 1997 Honda Accord, VIN# 1HGCE1828VA002933, MO TH6U8C** was towed.

On 11/29/2021 at 1850 hours, the victim viewed a photo lineup of Medlin but failed to pick him out of the lineup.

On 11/29/2021, detectives responded to the East Patrol Detention Center and conducted an interview with **Bryan Medlin**. A detective read the Miranda Warning and Waiver to him and he acknowledged he understood. **Bryan Medlin** provided the following statement: He left work at the BP convenience store around three in the afternoon and drove to his sister-in-laws house on Kensington. He lives in his car but she lets him stay on the property. He admitted that he owns a 1997 white Honda station wagon and that it is registered to him. He also admitted that he owns the Ruger pistol that was in his pants pocket when he was arrested. He purchased it several months ago at National Pawn on Truman Road. When asked if he had been to the recycling center on 13th Street on 11/28/2021, he stated that he had been to Nova Green and spent time at the homeless camp behind the business. He was then asked if he would be on video and he stated he was not sure. He then asked if this was involving what happened with the security guard at the recycling center. The detective informed him that it was and he refused to provide a further statement and the interview was concluded. As the detective was escorting him back to a cell he asked what he was being charged with and the detective informed him robbery. He then made the voluntary statement that he was confused because he had not stolen anything.

A check of **Bryan Medlin's** criminal history showed him to have no felony warrants or convictions.

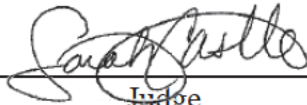
The underlying offense is related to a serious felony currently being investigated by Kansas City Missouri Police Department which is punishable by significant penalties that incentivize the defendant to fail to appear.
