WARRANT REQUESTED

Count I. Attempted Child Kidnapping (565.115-001Y20201099.1)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.115, RSMo, committed the class B felony of attempted child kidnapping, punishable upon conviction under Section 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about September 2, 2024, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant, who was not related within the third degree to SS, by blood or marriage, knowing the defendant had no right to do so, grabbed child under the age of fourteen years, and pulled her toward his residence, and defendant tried to remove from outside without the consent of the child's parent or guardian.

An individual convicted and sentenced for this offense shall not be eligible for parole until eighty-five percent of the sentence is served.

The range of punishment for a class B felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than five (5) years and not to exceed fifteen (15) years.

Count II. Sexual Misconduct Involving A Child Under 15 - 1st Offense (566.083-002Y20203699.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 566.083, committed the class E felony of sexual misconduct involving a child, punishable upon conviction under Sections 566.083, 558.011, and 558.002, RSMo, in that, the defendant knowingly induced a child less than fifteen years of age, to expose genitals for the purpose of arousing the sexual desire of defendant, and defendant is subject upon a finding of guilt to lifetime supervision under Section 217.735, RSMo, and defendant is subject upon a finding of guilt to lifetime supervision under Section 217.735, RSMo.

The range punishment for a class E felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than one (1) year and not to exceed four (4) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

Count III. Assault- 4th Degree - Pursuant To Subdivision (6) (565.056-009Y20201399.0)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 565.056, RSMo, committed the **class C misdemeanor of assault in the fourth degree**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about September 3, 2024, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant knowingly caused physical contact with knowing that such person would regard such conduct as offensive or provocative.

The range of punishment for a class C misdemeanor is imprisonment in the county jail or other authorized penal institution for a term not to exceed fifteen (15) days; by a fine not to exceed seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the statement(s) of facts filed contemporaneously herewith, made a part hereof, and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.



On 09/03/2024, at approximately 1200hrs, officers with the Kansas City Missouri Police Department were dispatched to an address in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri in regard to a sex offense. Officers contacted

On 09-03-2024, at approximately 1500hrs, an officer with the Kansas City Missouri Police Department was notified of an assault that occurred between two inmates in the Metro Detention facility.

The officer contacted the Victim, who was in jail for a separate, unrelated incident. The Victim stated he was sleeping and he felt something touch his butt. He rolled over and observed an older man, later identified as Wesley McGlothlen, standing over him.

Detectives with the Kansas City Missouri Police Department then contacted the Victim at Research Medical Center. He stated he was in custody for an unrelated charge. He was sleeping in the detention cell, facing the wall, on the bench. He was woken up by an old white guy pulling his boxers down from behind. He asked the male what he was doing and the male said something to the effect of "he looked cold" or "he was cold", but whatever it was didn't make any sense. He then jumped up and told the male to get away from him. The Victim described the male as an old white guy in his 70s, wearing sweats and a sweater type top (identified as Wesley McGlothlen). The Victim knew it was Wesley McGlothlen because all the other males were asleep in the cell. The Victim wants to press charges because he heard Wesley Mcglothlen was in jail for touching little kids. It should be noted Wesley McGlothlen was being held in custody on a 24hr investigative arrest under CRN 24-067661.

Officers then contacted the Victim, who stated yesterday, on 09/02/2024, at approximately 1700hrs, she was playing in her front yard outside of a residence in Kansas City Missouri, Jackson County. Wesley MCGLOTHLEN came out of his residence and asked her if she wanted chocolate. She told him no several times, but he kept asking. MCGLOTHLEN then grabbed her by the arm and pulled her inside his residence, and he then attempted to close the door behind him. The door did not close all the way. MCGLOTHLEN then pulled down her pants. She screamed and ran out of the front door and back to her residence. She then told her parents.

On 09/03/2024 responded to the Child Protection Center for a forensic interview. During her interview stated on 09/02/2024 she was approached by MCGLOTHLEN who asked her if she wanted some candy.



denied the offer. MCGLOTHLEN then asked her again, stated after MCGLOTHLEN asked multiple times she told him she would take some candy. stated MCGLOTHEN then grabbed her hand and pulled her into his apartment. Once they got inside MCGLOTHLEN's apartment he pulled down pants with his hands. described MCGLOTHLEN as an old white man with white hair on his face and that he was stinky. stated after MCGLOTHLEN pulled down his pants she got scared and screamed. had a toy car that MCGLOTHLEN had given her she threw the car at MCGLOTHLEN and believes she hit him in the face. then ran out of MCLOTHLEN's residence.

On 09/04/2024 Detectives of the Kansas City Police Department conducted a phone interview with (Mother of VIC). She stated on 09/02/2024 she was outside with and looked away for a short time and did not see returned to her and stated MCGLOTHLEN tried to give her candy and pulled her into the home. Screamed and escaped from him. Detectives also spoke with

On 09/04/2024 Detectives of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department responded to 7601 Prospect (Metro Patrol Division) to interview MCGLOTHLEN. MCGLOTHLEN was advised of his Miranda Rights and stated that he understood them and wished to provide a statement. MCGLOTHLEN was then confronted about luring the girl into his apartment on the premise of giving her candy, as well as an incident three weeks ago where he lured a little boy, ALD, into his apartment with the promise of a puppy and helped the boy go to the bathroom. MCGLOTHLEN was also confronted about sexual assault allegation while he was in the Metro Detention facility on 09-03-2024. MCGLOTHLEN then asked if he was being accused of being a pedophile. MCGLOTHLEN then stated he asks the kids if they want sweets because their parents are strict and won't let them have sweets.

MCGLOTHLEN was then asked what he was trying to do three weeks ago when he pulled the little boy's pants down and helped him pee, but he continued to say he just wanted to help him pee. The sexual assault in Metro Detention happened because the man was asleep and he looked cold, so he was trying to adjust his clothing for him. The time in the cell is the only time he has ever done something like that to a stranger. He missed his boyfriend so that was the motivation to grab the person in the cell.

MCGLOTHLEN then stated his goal is not pedophilia when he gives kids candy. MCGLOTHLEN admitted he panicked when the kids screamed after he pulled their pants down because he knows it is wrong. His sex life at home isn't satisfying him. MCGLOTHLEN then admitted he gives little kids candy and toys in exchange for looking at them with their pants down. He does it for sexual satisfaction. He does it in the basement. He doesn't touch the kids, he just looks. He can't remember how many kids have been in his apartment. Maybe five or six other kids.

MCGLOTHLEN was then asked about the little boy from three weeks ago who he helped go to the bathroom. MCGLOTHLEN was asked if he ever touched the boy, and he stated maybe, but he can't remember. He thinks it is possible because the little boy said "ouch". It was an accident. MCGLOTHLEN then clarified the boy said "ow, you're hurting me" and his fingernails were on the boy's penis. He put the boy in his lap, without the little boy's pants on, because he probably felt the need to get aroused. He wanted to get aroused because he is a lonely man. He was also touching the little boy's penis while he was in his lap.

He started doing stuff with kids about six months ago. He has only pulled down two kids pants, the two kids that he has been talking about today. He didn't have any illusions of having sex with them. He knew if he touched them wrong they would tell their parents and he would be in a lot of trouble. He can't say that he didn't get some satisfaction from pulling their pants down. He doesn't know why he pulled the girl's pants down because he is attracted to boys. He didn't want to have sex with the girl because a penis wouldn't even fit because she is too small. He pulled up her dress because he wanted to know what she looked like underneath. He had fantasies about having sex with her, but he is smart enough to know they couldn't be fulfilled. He was

hoping she would get scared and run away because then he couldn't take his urges any further. He would have taken the urges further had she not have run away.

MCGLOTHLEN then admitted that he has pedophilia tendencies, and he has had these tendencies as long as he can remember. His favorite age group is teenagers, but the youngest he has ever thought about is the two kids he has been talking about today.
