Upon Sentencing Hearing
Sentence to MDAI - No Probation

On APRIL 18, 2025 this matter comes on for sentencing hearing. The State appears by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, **MITCHELL J WIDENER**. The Defendant appears in person and by attorney, **HANNAH CHLOE LOMAX-VOGT**.

This matter was before the Court on **MARCH 3, 2025**. The Defendant entered a plea of guilty to the following:

Thereafter a Sentencing Assessment Report was ordered and has since been reviewed by the parties and the Court.

The Court, upon allocution as to whether there is any legal cause why judgment and sentence should not be pronounced and finding none, proceeds with sentencing.

The Court, having considered the evidence and arguments of counsel, along with other relevant factors, enters the following orders:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Defendant is sentenced and committed to the custody of the Missouri Division of Adult Institutions for incarceration for a term of **Twenty-Two (22) Years** as set out below:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant be given credit for all time served on the charge herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the State of Missouri recover from the Defendant the sum of Sixty-Eight (\$68.00) Dollars for the Crime Victims' Compensation Fund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the court costs shall be waived as the Defendant is indigent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant be remanded to the custody of the Sheriff for safekeeping and to await transport to the Missouri Division of Adult Institutions. The sheriff is authorized one additional officer/guard to transport the Defendant to the Missouri Division of Adult Institutions.

The Defendant has been advised of his right to post conviction relief pursuant to Missouri Supreme Court Rule 24.035, and the Court finds that there is no probable cause to believe the Defendant has been provided ineffective assistance of counsel.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

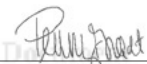
