Count I. Unlawful Discharge Of A Firearm - 1st Offense (571.031-003Y202452130)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of in violation of Section 571.031, RSMo, committed the class A misdemeanor of unlawful discharge of a firearm, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.004 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about June 21, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant recklessly discharged a firearm within the limits of the municipality of Kansas City, Missouri.

The range of punishment for a class A misdemeanor is imprisonment in the county jail or other authorized penal institution for a term not to exceed one (1) year; by a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime,

any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

Count II. Resisting/Interfering With Arrest, Detention Or Stop (575.150-003Y202048990)

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 575.150, RSMo, committed the class A misdemeanor of resisting an arrest, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002 and 558.011, RSMo, in that on or about June 22, 2025, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, a law enforcement officer was making an arrest of defendant, and the defendant knew or reasonably should have known that the officer was making an arrest, and, for the purpose of preventing the officer from effecting the arrest resisted the arrest of defendant by fleeing from the officer.

The range of punishment for a class A misdemeanor is imprisonment in the county jail or other authorized penal institution for a term not to exceed one (1) year; by a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime up to a maximum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the statement(s) of facts, filed contemporaneously herewith, made a part hereof, and submitted as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause.

Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that an arrest warrant be issued as provided by law.
