The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 06-22-2025, at approximately 0203 hours, officers of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department were conducting an area presence near the intersection of East 19th Street and Paseo Boulevard, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, for the 18th and Vine District.

Officers observed multiple people to run westbound on East 19th Street towards the intersection and directly from HOLMAN, Leonard Jr., (B/M [REDACTED]), who was holding a black in color Glock 17 Gen 5 semi-automatic pistol, 9mm caliber, serial number BXFF182, with 31-round extended magazine, in his hand. Officers observed HOLMAN discharge multiple rounds from his pistol into the air. Officers provided verbal commands to HOLMAN to drop the pistol and get down on the ground. HOLMAN disobeyed the officer's verbal commands and fled the scene on foot northbound in an alley from East 19th Street. Officers pursued HOLMAN on foot northbound through the alley for approximately 2 city blocks. Officers provided multiple verbal commands to HOLMAN to stop and get down on the ground which he refused to comply. HOLMAN ran into the eastbound lanes of East 17th Street, near the intersection of East 17th Street and Paseo Boulevard, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, and attempted to carjack an unknown white in color four door sedan by banging on the window and saying "get out, get out, get out" to the occupants. HOLMAN then jumped into and concealed himself, by laying down, within the open bed of a black in color Ford F150 pickup truck, bearing Missouri Temporary license "[REDACTED]", which traveled eastbound on East 17th Street towards the intersection. Officers stopped the pickup truck near the intersection and took HOLMAN into custody without further incident. Officers located HOLMAN's pistol in the open bed of the pickup truck. It should be noted that while HOLMAN was in police custody, he spontaneously stated "I was shooting in the air to protect myself... that was it" and "I wasn't shooting at nobody... I shot in the air".

Detectives reviewed city traffic cameras and observed HOLMAN run southbound on Vine Street to the intersection of East 19th Street and Vine Street, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, retrieve his pistol from his waist band and discharge his pistol in the air multiple times. HOLMAN did cause a large crowd of citizens to flee the immediate area and seek the protection of nearby objects, vehicles, and buildings for their safety. HOLMAN ran from the intersection westbound on East 19th Street and continued to discharge his pistol in the air. Officers contacted HOLMAN in the middle of East 19th Street and he fled from officers northbound through

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an alley. HOLMAN ran to East 17th Street and jumped into the open bed of a pickup truck. Officers stopped the pickup truck, took custody of HOLMAN, and recovered his firearm.

Detectives contacted HOLMAN at Kansas City Police Department Metro Patrol Detention, located at 7601 Prospect Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, however, he refused to exit the detention cell and speak with detectives.

Due to the aforementioned facts, HOLMAN exhibits a clear danger to the Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri community at large.
