(Description of Identity) The facts supporting this belief are as follows: Not an Official Court Document Not an Official Court Document On 07/11/2025 at 2336 hours officers with the Kansas City Missouri Police Department were dispatched to the area of 1125 Grand Blvd, Kansas City, Jackson County, MO on a reported sound of shots. Additional officers who were working in an off-duty capacity at The Power and Light District, E 13th and Grand Blvd, Kansas City, Jackson County, MO responded to the area as well. Multiple duplicate calls were placed for sound of shots in the areas of E 13th St and Grand Blvd and E 12th St and Grand Blvd. Det. Zylstra was working for the Law Enforcement Resource Center (LERC) when the incident was reported and began to review city cameras in the area. Det. Zylstra observed a black male wearing all black with dreadlocks and glasses (later identified as Sincere Miller (SUS3), a light skinned black male wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and gray pants (later identified as (SUS1) and a black male wearing a white hat, white tank top and blue jean shorts (later identified as (SUS2) walking through a parking lot located between E 12th St and E 13th St. Miller was observed holding an AK-47 style rifle is observed holding a handgun. Det. Zystra relayed what he observed on city camera to responding officers. Motan Official Court Document - Notan Official Court Document - Notan Official Upon arrival, multiple witness officers heard multiple sound of shots and observed shooting their firearms towards The Grand Apartment Complex, 1125 Grand Blvd, Kansas City, Jackson County, MO while standing outside of a silver 2010 Mercedes Benz C300 (and Miller were taken into custody by officers without incident. The incident was also captured on city cameras within the area.

Three occupied apartments within The Grand were struck by the gunfire. al Court Document Not an Official Court Document Not an Official Court Document Not an Officers on scene were notified by Titan Security Officers who were on scene that one of the security officers discharged his firearm towards Miller, and the silver Mercedes Benz during the incident. Officers observed a single apparent bullet hole in the windshield of the Mercedes Benz. (OTH3) who stated he was working as an armed security officer for Detectives interviewed Titan Security during the incident. He was assigned The Power and Light District near E 13th St and Grand Blvd when he heard radio traffic regarding several armed parties. He began to move into the area and observed multiple armed parties and observed a green dot and believed it was a laser. He stated the armed individuals began firing at him and he shot towards them 3-5 times. Detectives interviewed PO Stabler, PO Ratterman, PO Saragusa, PO Sprinkle and PO Sanderson. All officers were working in an off-duty capacity at The Power and Light District and their statements were similar. The officers stated they received radio transmission that a group of armed parties were in the area of E 13th St & Grand Blvd and were observed through police cameras. All officers responded to the area and heard multiple sound of shots, observed muzzle flash and observed and Miller firing their guns towards The Grand Apartment Building. Detectives interviewed Miller after he read the Miranda Warning and stating he understands his rights. Miller stated he went to The Power and Light District to drop off his brother () and friend. They arrived in his silver Mercedes Benz and parked in a parking lot close to The Power and Light District where they were hanging out with friends. His daughter was in the back seat of his vehicle while he was talking with friends. While hanging out, one of his friends told him someone was pointing a green laser at him. He turned around and observed a green beam on his chest. He believes the green beam was coming from a group of people at the intersection of E 12th St and Grand Blvd. Shortly after he heard multiple gun shots and grabbed his AK-47 style rifle and began to walk around the area. He observed the green beam multiple times during the incident and was attempting to enter his silver Mercedes Benz when he observed the green beam again, coming from The Grand apartment building. He stated he got scared and when he saw the green beam on his daughter, he lost it. He stated he was in fear for his life and his daughter's life. When asked if he thought he was going to hit the person pointing the laser at him, he stated he goes to the range and can hit a target at 50 yards with his rifle. I respectfully request a warrant with a bond associated to that warrant. While Miller might have felt threatened due to the gunfire prior to the incident and the green beam, he showed recklessness by firing a rifle towards an occupied high-rise apartment building, striking multiple occupied apartments. According to Google earth, the distance from where Miller fired his rifle to The Grand apartment complex is approximately 122 yards. Miller

has no prior felony convictions.
