The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 2/21/2025 at approximately 2227 hours, Kansas City, Missouri Police Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri on a medical call. Upon their arrival, Emergency Medical Services were providing medical care to, S [REDACTED] J [REDACTED] (W/M, [REDACTED]). At approximately 2257 hours, they declared S [REDACTED] deceased. A cell phone recovered near his body was identified as his by his family. A later autopsy determined S [REDACTED] cause of death was combined fentanyl and ethanol use.

The residence belonged to S [REDACTED] mother and step-father, who were present at the scene. They were interviewed by KCPD and stated the following: S [REDACTED] was addicted to fentanyl. Approximately two weeks prior, S [REDACTED] overdosed while riding in an Uber.

S [REDACTED]' mother and stepfather provided written consent to search S [REDACTED]' cell phone. A forensic examination of S [REDACTED] cell phone showed the following: Text message history with (816) [REDACTED] dating from 2/1/2025 to 2/21/2025. The number was saved under the contact "Caitlin Anderson". CLEAR showed the phone number was linked to ANDERSON, CAITLIN (W/F, [REDACTED]). S [REDACTED] sent messages to ANDERSON on several occasions consistent with him arranging to buy drugs from ANDERSON. S [REDACTED] asked to purchase "raw". In a conversation with another number, S [REDACTED] defined raw: "Raw fet is carfentanyl. 4x stronger than pharmaceutical fentanyl." ANDERSON and S [REDACTED] discussed drug pricing, drug availability, and coordinated meeting. On 2/6/2025, ANDERSON texted S [REDACTED] to meet at [REDACTED] Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri was the listed DOR address for ANDERSON. S [REDACTED] communicated that he took the bus to the park in front of her house and what he was wearing. Later text messages indicated that ANDERSON paid for an Uber to take S [REDACTED] home and that he overdosed while riding in the Uber. S [REDACTED] told ANDERSON he found the remaining drugs and offered to give it back to her. He sent ANDERSON a picture that appeared to be of drugs from his overdose. She sent him ride notifications that she sent an Uber to pick up the drugs. A map on the notification showed the ride was headed to the area of [REDACTED]

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Over the next few days, S █████ asked to buy from ANDERSON again. On 2/20/2025, ANDERSON sent “Bro I’m just scared bc of what happened last time and I don’t want nobody dieing or ending up in prison”. S █████ replied with several messages trying to convince her to sell to him. She eventually sent a message saying, “Well I kno my plug don’t wanna meet wit u specifically bc I did tell him the night you OD that that happened and now u kno he don’t want his number in ur phone and shit for if something were to happen and then he catch a case bc u was the last one to meet him ya kno so if u can find a ride over here then he would serve me and I could give it to u”.

They coordinated meeting and on 2/21/2025 at approximately 1813 hours, ANDERSON told him to walk over. S █████ replied that he was out front and ANDERSON sent: “Will u delete our convo please?? Sorry I’m being paranoid”. S █████ was declared deceased by KCFD approximately two and a half hours after this text was received.

On 7/16/2025 at approximately 1200 hours, KCPD detectives conducted a residence check at █████. ANDERSON came to the door and voluntarily agreed to come to Police Headquarters for an interview. On the 6th Floor, I conducted an interview with ANDERSON, I read her the Miranda Warning from the card and she said that she understood. During the interview, ANDERSON stated the following: █████ was her exclusive drug dealer. She bought approximately 0.2 grams of powder Fentanyl from him every two days from September 2024 until 7/15/2025. She met S █████ working at UPS and he was another fentanyl user like her. She recounted that S █████ came over to her apartment, █████ Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, to get drugs. She called █████ who sold her approximately 0.5 grams of powder fentanyl, which she gave to S █████, who then gave her approximately 0.1 grams of fentanyl for arranging the deal. She said she ordered S █████ an Uber to get home. S █████ later told her that he overdosed in that Uber that she ordered on his behalf. S █████ later contacted her again trying to obtain fentanyl. Again, S █████ came to her apartment, where █████ sold ANDERSON approximately 0.5 grams of powder fentanyl, and S █████ split this purchase of Fentanyl with ANDERSON in exchange for arranging the deal. On that occasion, S █████ gave her approximately half of the drugs. She never heard from S █████ again. When told that S █████ died from a Fentanyl overdose, ANDERSON expressed remorse and started crying.
