(Description of Identity)

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 07/10/2025 at approximately 1611 hours, Officers of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department were dispatched to the area of [REDACTED], Kansas City, Jackson County Missouri on a reported shooting.

Upon arrival, Officers located an adult, black male victim lying on the ground suffering from an apparent gunshot wound to the chest. Officers also located a female victim suffering from multiple apparent gunshot wounds. EMS arrived on scene and transported the black female to an area Hospital, EMS confirmed the black male victim deceased on scene at 1620 hours. The death has been ruled a Homicide by the Jackson County Medical Examiner's Office.

While on scene officers received an update from Dispatch advising the Grandview Police Department observed a Red Hyundai Sedan bearing Missouri License plate [REDACTED] on their Flock cameras located at [REDACTED] at 1611 hours driving southbound. When running the License Plate through MULES it response back to K'Von Goetz with a DOR address [REDACTED]

The 990 Homicide Squad responded and began investigating. During the course of the investigation Detectives interviewed multiple witnesses and two victims.

[REDACTED] stated she was asleep in her residence when her boyfriend, [REDACTED] (the deceased), woke her up after hearing a commotion outside. When [REDACTED] went outside, they saw her mother, [REDACTED], arguing with **K'Von Goetz** (suspect), who is the boyfriend of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was asking **Goetz** to leave, and [REDACTED] tried to deescalate by stepping between them and telling [REDACTED] to go back inside.

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Goetz wanted [REDACTED] to get into his car, but [REDACTED] refused. The argument continued. **Goetz** then retrieved a firearm from his vehicle and pointed it at the group. In an attempt to diffuse the situation, [REDACTED] got into **Goetz's** red car and began driving away slowly, hoping **Goetz** would follow her.

Instead, **Goetz** struck the windshield with his gun and yelled at her to get out. When [REDACTED] didn't stop, **Goetz** began shooting into the vehicle, hitting [REDACTED] multiple times. [REDACTED] said **Goetz** eventually pulled her from the car and fled the scene. [REDACTED] didn't know when [REDACTED] was shot. [REDACTED] confirmed there was no physical fight, only a verbal argument and repeated requests for **Goetz** to leave. [REDACTED] later learned she had suffered gunshot wounds to her left arm, right breast, and right arm, and her left arm was fractured.

[REDACTED] stated she lives at [REDACTED] with her [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] had been dating K'Von **Goetz** for about two years, and **Goetz** regularly drove [REDACTED] to and from work since she doesn't have a car.

On the afternoon of 07/10/2025, [REDACTED] was upstairs in her bedroom arguing with **Goetz** over the phone about a TikTok post. [REDACTED] began hearing a disturbance and went outside, where she saw **Goetz** standing near his red Hyundai parked across the street. [REDACTED] were by [REDACTED] vehicle, shouting at **Goetz** to leave, but **Goetz** refused, saying he was in a public area.

Goetz retrieved a handgun from his car. [REDACTED] tried to deescalate by stepping between **Goetz** and her family and told them she would go with **Goetz**. [REDACTED] saw [REDACTED] get into **Goetz's** vehicle and begin driving away. **Goetz** ran alongside the car, yelled for [REDACTED] to get out, and fired three to four shots into his own vehicle.

As the car continued northbound and [REDACTED] exited, [REDACTED] ran toward **Goetz**. **Goetz** then shot [REDACTED] twice and fled the scene in his vehicle. [REDACTED] ran barefoot after him but returned shortly after. [REDACTED] confirmed no one else had a weapon and, during a formal interview, identified **Goetz** from a photograph.

[REDACTED]

On 07/10/2025, [REDACTED] was sitting in her Dodge Durango parked on the west side of [REDACTED] when **Goetz** pulled up across from her. [REDACTED] overheard **Goetz** yelling on the phone, likely to [REDACTED] demanding she come outside. [REDACTED] told **Goetz** he wasn't allowed at the house, but **Goetz** replied that it was a public street and began calling her names. As [REDACTED] tried to photograph his license plates, **Goetz** approached her, and they began arguing.

[REDACTED] came outside, followed by [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. All were telling **Goetz** to leave. [REDACTED] stated **Goetz** began grabbing [REDACTED] trying to force her into his car while yelling at her to get in. [REDACTED] told **Goetz** to stop. During the argument, **Goetz** retrieved a black handgun from his vehicle and tucked it into the front of his pants. [REDACTED] told him he didn't need the gun.

[REDACTED] believed **Goetz** shot [REDACTED] first, then shot toward his vehicle, hitting [REDACTED]. As [REDACTED] turned to check on a grandchild crying at the doorway, she heard gunshots. [REDACTED] turned back and saw **Goetz** actively shooting. [REDACTED]

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was lying in a lawn to the north, and [REDACTED] was down in the street. [REDACTED] initially thought [REDACTED] may have entered **Goetz's** car for cover.

[REDACTED] ran to [REDACTED] who was gasping for air, then to [REDACTED] who had multiple gunshot wounds. After officers arrived, [REDACTED] mentioned she typically keeps a gun in a case but found it missing. [REDACTED] later returned holding the gun case. [REDACTED] didn't know why [REDACTED] had it, but heard her making angry statements about "doing something to that boy." The gun was a .38 revolver in a blue/green color.

[REDACTED] confirmed that no one other than **Goetz** had a firearm during the incident. [REDACTED] stated **Goetz** has a history of violence toward [REDACTED] including biting her and pointing a gun at her. [REDACTED] provided text messages from 06/24/2025 where she told **Goetz** he wasn't welcome at the house and gave his phone number as [REDACTED]. This number was also confirmed with [REDACTED].

During a formal interview [REDACTED] described **Goetz** as a mixed Black male with a thin build, dreadlocks that are blonde and brown, and glasses. [REDACTED] stated she's known him for a long time and would recognize him on the street. [REDACTED] positively identified him in a photo, which she signed and dated.

[REDACTED] also stated that **Goetz** drives a newer model red or burgundy four-door sedan, possibly a Hyundai Elantra, with tinted windows.

Goetz is not in police custody at this time.
