claimed responsibility for the victim's death. The Executive Director refused to provide the witness' name to be contacted by detectives.

On 09-20-2025 at 0800 hours, a body examination of the victim was conducted by members of the Jackson County, Missouri Medical Examiner's Office. A Preliminary Anatomic Diagnosis conducted by the Medical Examiner's Office determined the victim's cause of death as "Blunt force trauma of the head", and the manner of death as "Homicide".

On 09-27-2025 at approximately 0620 hours, Dianna Brown called police stating she wanted to turn herself in for the murder of involving an apartment fire on Independence Avenue in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. Dianna Brown was taken into police custody and transported to Police Headquarters to provide a statement.

On 09-27-2025 at approximately 0750 hours, Homicide Detectives interviewed Dianna Brown. Brown stated she's known for nearly 20 years and was a friend to him. On Sunday evening (09-14-2025), she was with at his apartment, Avenue. She and had an argument, based on wanting to have sex with her. Brown did not want to have sex with at that time, as had not showered recently. Brown stated you in her face, while poking her forehead with his finger. Brown was on the couch and attempted to get up, but was pushed back down by shown stated she and seventually stopped arguing, and went to sleep. Brown was unaware of how much time passed after the argument, but she just "snapped". As was in bed, sleeping and snoring, Brown used a nearby hammer to strike in the face, as stated by Brown "I swung with all my might". Brown stated that after first striking in the face with the hammer, tried to fight, but his "movements were weak". Brown then struck in the chest with the hammer and then in his groin area. With regard to how many times she struck with the hammer, Brown stated "I couldn't stop hitting him." Brown stated she continued to strike with the hammer even after realizing he was dead. Brown stated with regard to killing "He didn't deserve that".

Brown stated that after killing, she "rinsed off" and "wiped down", the hammer she used and moved the hammer to the vacant apartment directly across the hall. Brown stated she continued to live at the apartment, and slept there "every night until the night I set the fire", as lay deceased inside it. Brown had a guest, described by Brown as a "Mexican boy", over to the apartment one evening. After seeing see deceased body, the guest told Brown he would not tell, and left the apartment.

Brown stated that on the day she set the fire, a Friday, began to smell "so bad". Brown used two bottles of lighter fluid to douse, the clothing she wore when she killed, and anything she believed could be used to identify her. Brown stated, "I wanted to cover up everything, everything that I did, him, the clothes I wore, and anything that would identify me".
