VICTIM 1 was later interviewed who stated he was working security at the location. The suspect, at one point, took his shirt off and was drawing the attention of the owners. The business also had a re-entry policy that if the

customer leaves and goes outside they must pay a re-entry fee. VICTIM 1 told the suspect that next time he left he would have to pay to come back in. The suspect started arguing with VICTIM 1. VICTIM 1's family was trying to leave at the same time and could not get out because the suspect was in the door way. The suspect called VICTIM 1's mom a bitch, so VICTIM 1 verbally confronted the suspect. Another male went and got a firearm from a vehicle and handed it to the suspect. The suspect fired one shot in the air, and then pointed the firearm at VICTIM 1 and everyone else inside. VICTIM 1, in self-defense, pulled his Glock pistol out and fired one round at the suspect, when his magazine fell out of his gun. VICTIM 1 realized he was shot and ran inside for help. VICTIM 1 described the suspect as a black male, light-skinned, skinny, shoulder length dread locks, black t-shirt, blue jeans, and approximately 6'0.

The mother of VICTIM 1, (WITNESS 1), who helped transport her son across the street for help, was interviewed and stated she was at the location with family, and their group decided to leave for the night. As they were leaving, a male (later identified as CUSHON) was being kicked out of the establishment. CUSHON was in the way of her group leaving so she asked him to move nicely several times. After CUSHON still did not move WITNESS 1 asked one more time and CUSHON said something to her that made VICTIM 1 mad. Her son VICTIM 1, a bouncer/security at the location, started arguing with CUSHON, while she tried to calm her son down. VICTIM 1 pushed past her while still yelling at CUSHON. She then heard gunshots, everyone rushed inside, and her son came inside stating he had been shot. Her group transported her son across the street to the fire station for help. Located inside of the transport vehicle, gold Lexus with Missouri license of the magazine. The firearm was missing the magazine.

Another witness. (WITNESS 2), was interviewed and stated as she and her group were leaving, she observed a male, later identified as **CUSHON**, arguing with VICTIM 1, the bouncer. An unknown light-skinned black male walked to a vehicle and returned to the entrance of the business. **CUSHON** then pulled a firearm from his waistband and fired one shot into the air, then at the direction of VICTIM 1. VICTIM 1 then returned fire on **CUSHON**. She described the male with the firearm as a black male, shoulder length dreadlocks, gold grill in his mouth, several tattoos to include one on his neck.

CUSHON was later released from the hospital and transported to a local detention facility. Detectives responded to interview CUSHON, and under a mirandized statement, stated he and his family were at the club. They were outside when they heard sounds of shots, so he ran away, but realized he had been shot. He got into an unknow vehicle with females who helped him find his family. He got in the vehicle with his family and then tried driving to a hospital, but was stopped by Raytown Police for speeding on the way. CUSHON stated he did not know who was shooting, and denied being in possession of a firearm or having any problems at the club. CUSHON admitted to being a previously convicted felon for burglary.

Detectives obtained video from several different places. One angle from inside of the club showed the argument between VICTIM 1 and CUSHON. CUSHON appeared to go outside and could no longer be seen. An unknown male could be seen taking what appeared to be a firearm out of his waistband and handing it to someone. Shortly afterwards the crowd started ducking and scattering. VICTIM 1 then pulled his firearm out and returned fire.
