PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

I, Rogelio Garcia, a Detective with the Independence, Missouri, Police Department, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true.

1. I have probable cause to believe that on 1/9/2023, at 1522 hours, Blake A Sajdak, (Race- White, Sex- Male, committed one or more criminal offenses in Jackson County, Missouri.
2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 01/10/2023, Independence Police Officers responded to an address in Independence, Jackson County, Missouri 64050 on a juvenile medical call for service. When PO Pablo arrived, he contacted the involved party [REDACTED], herein referred to as Involved 1. Involved 1 directed police and medical personnel to the basement of the residence. The juvenile, [REDACTED], herein referred to as Victim, was located on a bed. American Medical Response personnel transported Victim to Centerpoint Hospital, where she was pronounced deceased.

Victim's cellphone was recovered from the scene. A cut straw, which I know from my training and experience to be commonly used for ingesting narcotics nasally, was also recovered from the area where Victim was found.

On 02/23/2023, the Jackson County Medical Examiner's report was received. The report listed Doctor Ransom Ellis IV as the examiner with the signing date of 02-17-23. The cause of death was listed as Acute Fentanyl Intoxication with the Manner of Death being accidental.

On 01/24/2023, Detective Abraham delivered Victim's phone to RCFL for a forensic examination. On 10/26/2023, the phone was retrieved from RCFL along with a report of examination.

The extraction data was provided to a DEA analyst and a report was generated. The report provided the following leads for the dealer who supplied Victim:

-The phone number [REDACTED] (Contact: blakeo) had messages clearly indicating drug transactions between the sender and the Victim. Based on the messages, the sender delivered narcotics to Victim on 01/05/2023, 01/06/2023, 01/07/2023,

01/08/2023, and 01/09/2023. It should be noted Victim made several payments via Apple Cash to the sender.

-The Snapchat account @tr.blako (Contact: Blake) had messages clearly indicating drug transactions between the sender and the Victim. Based on the messages, the sender delivered narcotics to Victim on 01/09/2025. On the message thread, the sender stated "yea these ain't the regular ones these are stronger and these are still a deal for \$30."

Subpoenas were sent to T Mobile [REDACTED], Snap Inc, (@tr.blako), and Green Dot Inc due to them handling Apple Cash Transactions ([REDACTED]).

Detective Garcia received the returns on the submitted subpoenas on the following dates, for the indicated service provider:

- 06/12/2025; T Mobile
- 06/18/2025; Snap Chat
- 06/26/2025; Green Dot

Detective Garcia reviewed the T Mobile return, and the following relevant information was located:

The address is associated to Blake Sajdak (01/31/2003) through the department of revenue database, Independence Police Records, and other open source databases.

Detective Garcia reviewed the Snap Chat return, and the following relevant information was located:

Reference Snapchat account "@tr.blako" identified as the suspect's social media account through the deceased's cell phone extraction.

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On 09/09/2025, Suspect was arrested and transported to the Independence Police Department Detention Center. Detective Garcia conducted a post-Miranda interview with Suspect. Suspect confirmed the above accounts were his and provided his pedigree information. Suspect admitted to selling re-pressed fentanyl pills to Victim, recalling he delivered the pills to Victim the night of 01/09/2023 at approximately 930 pm to 1000 pm. Suspect advised those pills were often mixed with Fentanyl. For that specific transaction, Victim paid him through Apple Cash.

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Defendant shows a history of being arrested for Eluding Police Officer and Obstructing Police Officer.
