The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant, in violation of in violation of Section 575.155, committed the class D of endangering a correcton employee, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.002, 558.011 and 577.010, RSMo, in that on or about January 16, 2017, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, the defendant attempted to cause or knowingly caused C.O. a Jackson County Correction Officer, to come into contact with urine, and defendant is infectedwith hepatitis C.

The range punishment for a class D felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than two (2) years and not to exceed seven (7) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine.
